Work under this Contract will include geotechnical consulting services and materials testing services related to subgrade observations, compaction testing of soils, observation and compaction testing of hot mix asphalt production, cast-in-place concrete inspection, and concrete compression test cylinders. Completion time is limited to 90 calendar days.

Any Proposed Equal for a Standard shall be submitted to the Construction Manager no later than five (5) days prior to the bid opening. If no Addendum is issued accepting the Proposed Equal, the Proposed Equal shall be considered rejected.

Native American Preference related to contracting, subcontracting and suppliers in the project is required. Bidders shall also abide by Ordinance No. 89 which provides Indian preference in contracting goods and services.
