3) Marysville Fire District 12 December Report – Overview of monthly statistics provided by Chief McFalls

Looking at the statistics in comparison to last year, we have increased service by ten (10) percent. We are continuing to meet and work towards a Regional Fire Authority. 4) Tulalip Police Department December Report - overview of statistics provided by Interim Chief Pruitt Discussion: Interim Chief Pruitt, President Sheldon,

The new Tulalip Police Department Office Manager is currently working on a grant application for an infraction system. The system will allow us to scan a license and automatically generate an infraction, and add it to the Tulalip Tribal Court system. Interim Chief Pruitt has monthly meetings with Seattle Premium Outlets (SPO) to discuss overall consumer/employee safety, loss prevention, and provides safety tips for staff. President Sheldon asks he begin meetings with the Quil Ceda Village General Manager, and essential staff to begin having regular meetings as well.
