## THE CONSOLIDATED BOROUGH OF QUIL CEDA VILLAGE Ordinance No.8.01.1A

# Adopting Revised Fireworks Ordinance and repealing prior Ordinance 8.01.1

WHEREAS the Village Council is the governing body of the Consolidated Borough of Quil Ceda Village under the Village Charter approved by the Tulalip Tribes' Board of Directors pursuant to Ordinance 111, and

WHEREAS, the Village Council is empowered by Article I, Section 3 and Article II, Section I, and Article III, Section 3 (a) of the Charter to exercise governmental powers, and

WHEREAS, the Council previously enacted Ordinance 08.01.1 prohibiting ignition of fireworks, and

WHEREAS, the Council has determined this Ordinance needs clarification with regard to fireworks activities authorized by the Board of Directors at specific times and areas located within the boundaries of Quil Ceda Village.

**NOW THEREFORE BE ITORDAINED** that the Council of the Consolidated Borough of Quil Ceda Village repeals Ordinance 8.01.1, and adopts a restated Fireworks Ordinance as follows:

### Court Given Jurisdiction

The Tribal Courts of the Tulalip Tribes are hereby provided jurisdiction to hear and determine all causes brought under the Ordinances of the Consolidated Borough of Quil Ceda Village.

#### **Enforcement**

All commissioned law enforcement officers of the Tulalip Tribes are hereby granted authority to enforce the Ordinances of the Consolidated Borough of Quil Ceda Village

#### Fireworks Prohibited

The discharge or ignition of fireworks within the boundaries of Quil Ceda Village is prohibited, except at specific places and times authorized by the Tulalip Board of Directors. Any person found to have violated this prohibition shall be subject to a civil penalty not to exceed \$100.00 and in addition, shall be subject to having all fireworks in their possession confiscated and forfeited and shall be given an immediate eviction under escort from the Village boundaries. For purposes of this provision, "fireworks" shall have the same meaning as it has in Tulalip Tribal Ordinance 52, and the due process procedural provisions of the Tulalip Tribal Ordinance 114 shall apply to penalties levied.
