ADDENDUM NO. 3

I. Questions regarding project overview

- a. *Bid estimate: Is there an engineer's estimate or are the bids from last year available for assistance in creating an accurate estimate?*
 - i. **There is no engineer's estimate. Last year's winning bid was \$46,161.56**
- b. *For the submittal requirements under section V.C., could you elaborate on the request for the number of hours assigned for each task for all personnel. What kind of breakdown are you seeking?*
 - i. **Breakdown should include each task, number of expected hours, labor rate per hour, total cost for x4 (four) workers, total cost per task, and expected schedule.**
 - ii. **Jewelweed breakdown should include each area's estimate separately.**
 - iii. **Example of what the breakdown could look like below:**

- c. *Tulalip Business License: Do you need a business license with Tulalip Tribe prior to submission of the estimate?*
 - i. Receipt of Tulalip Tribes Business License will be required prior to signing of Contract after award of bid. Submittal of bid proposals does not require a Tulalip business license.
- d. *Post-Inspection Secondary treatments: Is there a limit to the number of times a contractor may be called back to the site to remove any remaining targeted plants? Is the expectation 100% removal as the standard?*
 - i. The Contractor will physically pull out and remove all spotted jewelweed (*Impatiens capensis*), including roots, by hand within the Coho Creek riparian buffers from the target areas indicated (**Attachment B**).
 - ii. A pre- and post-treatment inspection shall be arranged with Quil Ceda Village Contracting Officer's representative for each Task.
 - iii. Inspection will include an assessment of the treatment and if non-conforming to standard of complete removal, Contractor may need to complete a secondary treatment for correction.
- e. *Knotweed treatment (Task 4): What is the expectation for the knotweed treatment as there appears to be a call-back if the Tulalip does not seem the treatment is not up to an acceptable standard?*
 - i. The Contractor will treat Itadori knotweed via herbicide. Post-treatment inspection will include an assessment of the treatment and if non-conforming to standard of complete treatment, Contractor may need to complete a secondary treatment for correction.
- f. *Estimation of cost (Task 1): Which measurements should we use to determine the costs?*
 - i. Acreages described in the Attachment G – Summary Tables are correct.
 - ii. An artifact appeared from prior geometry calculations on the labeling of some areas in the **Attachment B** maps.
