I. REVIEW of Pre-Submittal Site Visit from RFP

Applicants are encouraged to attend a site visit prior to submitting a proposal. The site visit is scheduled for February 9th from 9:30am – 12:30pm, contingent on weather and site conditions. Any changes to site visit date will be communicated through addenda as necessary. Site visit will include traversing uneven and flooded terrain to access task areas outlined in Scope of Work. Please email Contracting Officer representative, lwright@tulaliptribes-nsn.gov, 48 hours prior to scheduled visit to coordinate vehicle access to the site.

II. UPDATE information regarding Site Visit

This site visit will involve an office briefing followed up with a field site excursion. The office briefing will occur at the Tulalip Data Services building at 2601 88th St NE, Tulalip, WA 98271 in Conference Room 214, starting at 9:30am February 9th, 2026. Following the briefing, we will head out in the field to observe the areas of work for the varied contract tasks. Vehicles with ground clearance will be necessary as the field sites are accessed through rough roads that have significant potholes and flooding.

The areas of work will include two primary conditions, inundated/muddy and brushy/thorny. As such, please bring clothing that can get snagged on prickly vegetation, gloves, and muck/rain boots. Waders are highly recommended.

The office briefing presentation and any questions asked during the site visit will be included in an RFP addendum following the completion of the site visit.
